### **Swearing In of New Members** – *TAD*

Prior to the start of the meeting, the CUE will swear in the members whose terms begin January 1, 2016.

### <u>Item 5</u>: Award of Lear-Nagle Sanitary Sewer Force Main Project – TAD

The Lear-Nagle Sanitary Sewer Force Main Project bids are intended to be opened January 4, 2016. Currently, there are five companies holding plans and specifications for the project. Given favorable bid results, the bid tabs and a request for award will be made at the January 5, 2016 meeting, with information intended to be sent out prior to the meeting.

The proposed project is the least-cost alternative to abate surcharges in the Lear Road pumping station. In making this decision, the Principles that would help guide the Board are:

- Maintain existing assets, while investing in infrastructure that will take us into the future.
  - Exercise fiduciary responsibility.

### Recommended motion:

I move to award the Lear-Nagle Sanitary Sewer Force Main Project to the least-cost, responsive and responsible bidder, \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, for a bid price of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ based upon current unit quantities, pending approval of the Ohio Water Development Authority loan for the project. Furthermore, I authorize the CUE to consider and approve, as appropriate, changes that total no more than an additional 10% above the bid price.

### Item 6: **Proposed Wastewater Rates** – *TAD*

With \$46 million in wastewater protects anticipated to start in 2016, wastewater debt service will increase from the current \$1 million per year to \$4.5 million per year by 2022. In the absence of significant growth or identifying major new revenue sources, rates must increase to help bring in the additional \$3.5 million per year for debt service. Currently, it appears revenues and expenses will approximately balance if rates increase by 15% per year in 2016 through 2021 based upon the current anticipated capital improvement plan. As it has been in the past, only two years of rate increases are sought so that any offsets by reducing expenses or additional sales may be accounted prior to subsequent rate increases.

Avon Lake has maintained rates well below the state average, with the average Avon Lake residential customer currently paying approximately \$62 per quarter for wastewater service. The proposed new rates would raise the average to approximately \$71 per quarter for bills issued after July 1, 2016 and \$82 per quarter for bills issued after July 1, 2017. Should the quarterly bills rise to a level greater than some families can easily afford, Avon Lake Regional Water

offers payment plans either through direct withdrawals from customers' banks or through customer-initiated calls. Staff is currently investigating a new billing system and hope to have additional abilities for alternate payment arrangements with that system.

Given the historical changes in wastewater rates across the state, even with these increases, Avon Lake's bills should remain in the bottom 25% statewide.

The proposed wastewater rate increases will allow Avon Lake Regional Water to continue with the projects identified for the Water Quality Enhancement Strategic Initiative, including the WPCC rehabilitation/upgrades, combined sewer separations, and sanitary surcharge abatement. In addition, in making this decision, the Principles that would help guide the Board are:

- Provide quality, affordable water services.
- Maintain existing assets, while investing in infrastructure that will take us into the future.
- Exercise fiduciary responsibility.

# Board of Municipal Utilities Work Session Minutes December 15, 2015 201 Miller Road Avon Lake. Ohio

The work session was called to order at 6:08 PM.

Present: Mr. Berner, Mr. Dzwonczyk, Mr. Rickey, and Mr. Rush.

Also present: Candidate-Elect Schnabel, Mayor Zilka, Councilmember Fenderbosch, Chief Utilities Executive Danielson, Chief of Utility Operations Eberle, and Community Outreach Specialist West.

### Draft Wastewater Rates

With \$46 million in wastewater projects anticipated to start in 2016 and annual debt service increasing from \$1 million in 2015 to \$4.5 million by 2022, the Chief Utilities Executive is proposing rate increases that are larger than previous years. He indicated that staff have identified cost-saving measures and will continue to do so, as well as help LORCO grow in order to help distribute costs among a larger user base. However, rates will also need to increase to help cover the lager increase in debt service. The CUE proposed increasing the per 1,000 gallon rate from the current \$3.63 to \$4.17 for bills issued after July 1, 2016 and to \$4.80 for bills issued after July 1, 2017.

Members understood the reasoning for the proposed increases, noted how staff worked to minimize and spread the increases over a longer period, and asked staff to identify ways to help make the additional burden easier

### **Water Tower**

The current Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) contract for the Storage Improvements Project was written with the option of adding construction of the water tower as an amendment. Staff has met with the CMAR and discussed tentative pricing for the project. Based upon that discussion, staff has asked the CMAR to secure bid pricing in order to establish a firm Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) early in 2016. Given a favorable GMP, staff will request the Board amend the current Storage Improvements Project CMAR contract to include construction of the water tower.

### Reports/Updates

### Chairman/Committee/Members Reports

The Chairman reported that he attended the Sewer Committee Meeting. Extensive discussions were had about use of Bramhall Engineering. Councilmember Fenderbosch said they are awaiting the Law of Director's opinion on this matter. Chairman and Candidate Elect reported the Sewer Committee would like to know more about our Business Plan for the Sewer Separation Project.

Mr. Rickey reported that he attended the HR meeting. No report necessary. Mr. Rickey also attended the LORCO meeting. The County has put out an offer about Hawke Road in Columbia, where roughly 40 residents on the east side, will be able to tie into LORCO, but it will be billed by Lorain County.

### CUE Report

CUE has internally discussed with staff the issue of customers that do not separate their sewers by February 2018. Need to consider instituting a new charge for storm water for

these customers. Also, a City ordinance has been approved for the conditional use of a water tower on the Walker site and the Mayor has been authorized to sign the loan application for the water tower on the Walker site.
