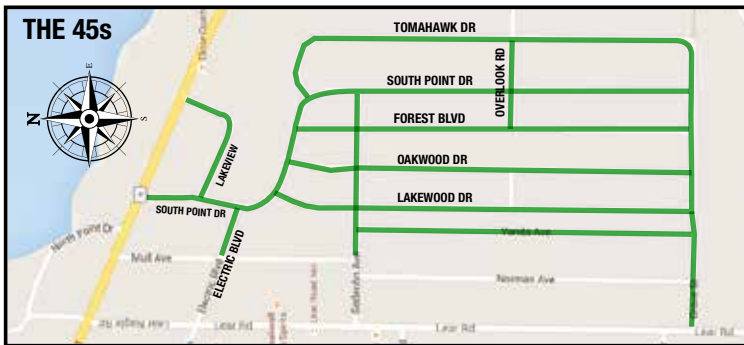

THE 45S: TIME TO SIGN UP FOR CONSTRUCTION EMAIL UPDATES

If you live on Lakewood, Oakwood, Forest, South Point, Tomahawk, Grove (between Lear and Tomahawk), Gedeohn (between Mull and South Point), Lakeview, Overlook (between Oakwood and Tomahawk), Vanda, Electric (between Mull and South Point), or Lake (between South Point and Lear), combined sewer separation construction will begin this fall. Avon Lake Regional Water hosted a resident information session on September 13th.

Once construction begins, Avon Lake Regional Water will send out periodic email updates. If you are interested in receiving these email updates, send us an email to updates@avonlakewater.org and we will make sure to include you. 💧

WASTEWATER CONTROL POLLUTION PLANT WINS TOP HONORS

On June 27th, Avon Lake Regional Water received the 2017 Ohio Water Environment Association Facility Image Award. This award recognizes water or wastewater treatment facilities that enhanced the physical image of their facility to promote a better image of the profession to the public.

Avon Lake Regional Water's Water Pollution Control Center is moving into the second year of its \$35 million rehabilitation project. Project improvements include upgrades to new ultraviolet disinfection units, new power generation system, upgrades to pumps, upgrades to tanks, and new solids press. 💧



RATE INCREASES

On July 1st, new water and wastewater rates went into effect. These rates go towards providing you with water and wastewater treatment services as well as infrastructure and capital improvement projects. Below are the water and wastewater rates.

Water rates (effective 7/1/17)

First	50,000 Gallons	@	1.85 per thousand
Next	200,000 Gallons	@	1.52 per thousand
Over	250,000 Gallons	@	1.27 per thousand

Minimum water bill is \$9.25, even if fewer than 5,000 gallons are consumed.

Wastewater rates (effective 7/1/17): \$4.80 per thousand gallons of water consumed. Along with your wastewater charges, \$8.25 is added each quarter as an administrative fee. 💧

Loans and Credits Available for Laterals

Financing is available to help with you with your lateral separation project. Avon Lake Regional Water is offering the Lateral Loan Program, which is a 10-year, 2%-interest loan (\$4,000 maximum), payable via your water/wastewater bill. Once you complete a lateral separation, you may qualify for a \$1,000 credit on your bill.
