



Annual CSO Notification - 2024

This annual report serves as notice for all the Combined Sewer Overflows (CSOs) that occurred at the Center Road Pump Station in Avon Lake from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

Long-Term Control Plan and Updates:

In 2019, Avon Lake Regional Water successfully completed its Long-Term Control Plan by eliminating all combined sewers in the City of Avon Lake. Avon Lake Regional Water's collection system is no longer a combined sewer system.

In 2020, at the request of Ohio EPA, Avon Lake Regional Water's Center Road Pump Station will remain a combined sewer overflow (CSO) location until completion of the monitoring period (2021), per its Long-Term Control Plan.

In 2022, at the request of Ohio EPA, Avon Lake Regional Water submitted an Evaluation Report summarizing the results of the monitoring program.

To date, Avon Lake Regional Water continues to monitor its entire collection system to determine what, if any, future work is necessary to prevent possible overflows.

2024 CSO Information:
