#### Call to Order - Roll Call

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

Present: Mr. Dzwonczyk, Mr. Phillips, Mr. Rush, and Ms. Schnabel.

Also present: Chief Utilities Executive Danielson, Mayor Zilka, Councilmember Fenderbosch.

#### Oath of Office

Newly appointed member Paul R. Phillips took the Oath of Office with CUE Danielson serving as Officiary.

#### **Approve Minutes**

Chairman Dzwonczyk presented the minutes of the January 17, 2017, Work Session and the January 17, 2017, Regular Meeting and with the deletion of Mr. Berner's name, ordered the minutes to stand and be distributed as amended.

#### Public Speakers – None.

**Correspondence** – CUE Danielson provided information to the Board on a customer who was unhappy with his late fees, this customer has been satisfied. CUE Danielson further informed the Board of a homeowner who was unhappy with the policy that the bill stays with the property.

#### Reports/Updates

Employee Promotion: Donald Hall received his Class I Distribution Certification this past year and now meets the Line Maintenance Man requirements. Based on the recommendation of his immediate supervisor and CUE concurrence, Mr. Hall has been promoted from Laborer Step 1C to Line Maintenance Man Step 1C.

Contract Update: During 2016, MWH Americas was purchased by Stantec. The CUE executed on the Board's behalf an assignment of the current MWH Americas contract to Stantec.

Job Description Updates: The CUE and senior staff continue to work both internally and with the HR Director on updates to job descriptions, including the redefining of the Executive Assistant and the GIS Analyst into new positions, and the rewriting of other new job descriptions.

Phone System Updates: An auto-attendant has been added to the phone system in order to best manage the increased phone calls due to the lateral separations and the construction projects and also allow the front-office staff to focus on other responsibilities. The auto attendant will help direct calls to the appropriate personnel.

Potential Appropriation: In late-2016, OWDA forwarded an approximate \$130,000 invoice to Avon Lake Regional Water for loan origination fees regarding the water pollution control center rehabilitation project. CUE Danielson expects these fees to be shown on the February 21, 2017 expenses. At the end of the third quarter, the CUE will further assess whether additional funds need to be appropriated to help pay for these expenses.

Lost Time Incident: A Line Maintenance Operator had an unfortunate accident on January 25, 2017 at the Water Filtration Plant. He is currently off work due to two broken fingers and a shattered bone in his heel.

#### Project Updates:

Water Tower: Initial tank bowl welding has begun for the bottom cone section. In order to make up lost time, crews are currently working seven days per week.

Water Plant: Continuing with the wash water recycling system and attenuation basins.

Wastewater Plant: Demolition of the old ultraviolet disinfection system has taken place.

The new system is in the process of being installed.

Lateral Loan Program: Since the last Board meeting, three additional agreements for the Lateral Loan Program have been executed, bringing the total to 34 properties, with \$109,400 (total) committed and \$28,550 paid so far. The average loan request is for approximately \$3,200.

#### CUE Action Items:

Below are responses to questions asked by the Board:

Debrief on how CMAR worked on the water project: As the project approaches substantial completion in March or April, staff will provide a synopsis regarding how well the construction manager at risk approach worked.

LORCO FPAs: LORCO is currently discussing with Elyria the potential for minor FPA boundary adjustments where one entity may be better able to provide service than the other. The process is proceeding congenially.

First Energy easements for Elyria interconnection: CUE Danielson is working with the Assistant Law Director on a draft of the easement language.

#### Chairman/Committee/Members Reports

Chairman Dzwonczyk reported he will attend the Sewer Committee meeting Thursday February 9, 2017.

### <u>Item 4A1</u>: **Employee Promotion** *TAD*

As a result of an upcoming retirement in the Distribution and Collection Department, an internal opening was posted for a new Laborer. Management interviewed candidates and promoted Tim Roten, Janitor (Step 3) to Laborer (Step 2, the next higher step) effective 3/13/17. By inclusion as an information item, the Board will recognize the promotion and wage change.

### Item 4A2: New Employee - TAD

With the upcoming promotion of the Janitor, internal and external postings were advertised for the open Janitor position. The Civil Service Commission held competitive examinations and provided Avon Lake Regional Water administration the top five candidates. An interview team unanimously selected Jason Kempton, our existing part-time pretreatment inspector to fill the position. Mr. Kempton successfully completed a pre-employment physical and background check and will begin in his new role on February 27, 2017. By inclusion as an information item, the Board will recognize the appointment of Mr. Kempton to WFP Janitor Step 1B effective February 27, 2017.

### Item 4A3: Job Description Updates - TAD

The draft Analyst/Assistant job description and wage range of \$40,000 to \$60,000 per year is intended to be reviewed by the HR Committee on February 21, 2017. The draft Engineer/Analyst job description and wage range is being finalized and should be reviewed by the HR Committee March 6, 2017. Both are attached for Board member comments.

### <u>Item 4A4</u>: Lateral Mailings – TAD

The first of the mailings prompted by the Council's passage of the Resolution of Necessity will be mailed on February 17, 2017. The actual quantity of letters mailed each week will vary in order to maintain a manageable inspection backlog. Yard signs are being regularly moved in order to correspond with the mailings in order to increase response rates.

### <u>Item 4A5</u>: Ward Meetings – TAD

Avon Lake Regional water attended the February 8, 2017, Wards 1&2 meeting and will also attend the February 22, 2017, Wards 3&4 meeting. Lateral separation requirements is the highlight of our presentation. On-going construction is also presented.

<u>Item 4A6</u>: **Project Updates** – *SCB* 

Water Tower: Tank bowl welding continues for the bottom cone section.

Water Plant: Will provide verbal update at meeting.

Wastewater Plant: The work for the WPCC administration building is nearly complete, and the UV system change-out is well underway. The west aeration basin will out of service for a week to facilitate equipment replacement.

Item 4A7: Lateral Loan Program – TAD

Since the last Board meeting, three additional agreement for the Lateral Loan Program has been executed, bringing the total to 39 properties, with \$127,300 (total) committed and \$42,550 paid so far. The average loan request is for approximately \$3,250.

Item 4A8: Shutoffs – TAD

Thursday, February 16, 2017, was the day for quarterly shutoffs. Water and wastewater bills are typically sent out on the last day of March, June, September, and December and are due on the 20<sup>th</sup> of the following month. Second notices are then sent out after that. Customers have approximately one week before a disconnect notice is sent out (usually providing two weeks' warning). When crews were dispatched at noon on Thursday to turn off accounts that had not paid, they were sent to 115 homes, which is approximately double the usual amount. By the end of our staffing time on shutoff day (8:30PM), 23 remained off. As of noon Friday, 10 remain off (which is a normal number).

Staff is trying to understand why the numbers were so much higher this quarter. Some indicated they had neglected to switch over to automatic payments as we had discussed with them during the previous cycle.

Item 4A9: **CUE Action Items** – *TAD* 

Below are responses to questions asked by the Board:

Safety audits: At the last meeting, Board asked about our safety audit program. Staff inspects emergency equipment such as eyewash stations and exit signs monthly and also inspects equipment such as ladders. The ladder that buckled was a former contractor's ladder left onsite and not part of the regular inspection program. New labeling is being placed on all Avon Lake Regional Water ladders in order to confirm regular inspections and that ladders will be taken out of service when they fail a safety inspection.

Buy American: The CUE has asked Ohio EPA to provide comment whether there may be problems working with engineering firms headquartered in foreign countries and complying with any Buy American requirements for federally-backed loans.

CMAR Debrief: At the beginning of the March 7, 2017 meeting, senior staff and the contractor will present a synopsis regarding how well the Construction Manager At Risk form of alternative project delivery worked for the Storage Improvements Project.
